Orientation Night for incoming 9th and 10th grade parents and students is from 7:15 -8:15 PM at Resurrection Church on Thursday, September 3rd.

Mission Statement: *As ambassadors for Christ, our mission is to reflect the love of Christ to all who enter our doors, expressing excitement and enthusiasm for the opportunity to share our church home and to welcome all visitors in such a way that they would be transformed from strangers into friends.*

Requirements:

1. **Life Nights/Online Small Groups and Holy Hour:** 12 Life Nights (which include the 3 mandatory nights - see below; pending safety regulations for COVID-19)/24 online small groups (in the event we have to do online classes - see below for details) and 3 Holy Hours which take place every Thursday at Resurrection from 8:30-9:30 PM.
2. **Three Mandatory Life Nights for Adults and Teens (pending safety regulations):** There will be three Life Nights this year that are mandatory for all teens in our Confirmation program and at least one parent. Sign-ins will be done to ensure attendance. The dates are as follows: 10/25/2020, 12/6/2020, and 1/31/2021. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!
3. **Attend Weekly Life Teen Mass:** Life Teen Mass takes place every Sunday from 5:30-6:30 PM at Resurrection Church. We strongly urge parents to attend that mass with their teens. If an individual isn't able to attend the Life Teen Mass on a particular Sunday, we ask that you email Jo-Ann Sullivan at resconfirmation@hinghamcatholic.org and Mickayla Hagar at mhagar@stpaulhingham.org
4. **Retreat:** Attend 1 Retreat to be held on Saturday, November 21st from 9 AM to 4 PM at Resurrection. If your child is not able to attend this retreat, they may go on a mission trip, Discipleship Week, CAMPS, or March for Life as a substitute. See below for more information and who to contact.
5. **Attend Two Mandatory Confirmation Classes:** There are two mandatory Confirmation classes that take place during 10th grade (Wednesday, March 31st from 6:30 to 8:00 pm, and Thursday, April 8th 6:30 to 8:00 pm). There will be a Catechism review trivia quiz during these classes. The exam can be found online, seasidelifeteen.org, under Resurrection Confirmation.
6. **Practice with Sponsors and Paperwork for Confirmation:** Your sponsor is someone who is a Confirmed and practicing Catholic and someone who can be a mentor in the faith. The date for practice, confession and prayer is Thursday, April 29th at Resurrection Church from 7:15 PM - 9:30 PM. More information about necessary paperwork will be made available throughout the year.

When: **Late April/Early May** at Resurrection Church. You will receive an email from Jo-Ann Sullivan, our Confirmation Director, when this information becomes available.

What are Life Nights? Our weekly youth ministry event known as Life Night takes place from 6:30 - 8 PM following the 5:30 PM Life Teen mass on Sundays at Resurrection Church. Life Nights are the primary time each week where social activities, current issues, or catechesis will be given in an engaging and relevant way. They are also times of fellowship, games, catechesis and community. Beyond Life Nights, this dynamic program will also be participating in outings, mission trips and much more! All of our events are open to everyone in grades 9-12! We invite you to check out our schedule of upcoming events on our website, seasidelifeteen.org.

What are Online Small Groups? Online small groups are groups of five persons of the same gender (3 Confirmation students, 1 Teen Core & 1 Adult Core) who journey together as disciples through weekly gatherings of fellowship, ongoing conversion, and learning. Groups meet at least twice a week, once for study (materials provided) and once for prayer. Each member will take turns leading the discussions, rotating every four weeks. Groups will work together to establish a consistent meeting day and time each week that works best for everyone's schedule and will meet virtually via Facetime, Zoom, Skype etc.

Life Night Descriptions:

- ❑ **Bad Religion** → In this series, we will reveal Christianity, specifically Catholicism, as a personal faith and religious tradition that inspires authentic discipleship of Jesus and evangelization.
- ❑ **Eyewitness** → In this series, we will discuss how historical and scriptural evidence proves that the Resurrection of Jesus is true and shows that He, in fulfilling every prophetic promise, conquered the grave. It will help teens grasp the hope and power of the Resurrection in their lives by examining the firsthand experiences of the disciples.
- ❑ **Immaculata** → This Life Night series encourages your teenagers to dive into their relationship with Jesus in a whole new way, and increase their relationship with our Blessed Mother, as well.
- ❑ **Signs and Wonders** → This is a Life Night series that will challenge teens to have expectant faith in God, who performs miracles as a way of revealing His power and goodness.

Requirement Breakdown:

- **12 Life Nights/24 Online Small Groups:** In order for your child to get the most out of our program, we are asking that they strive to attend consecutive Sundays. For example, our curriculum topics this year are set up in sets of 4 class cycles with each Sunday building on the last (see above). There will also be 3 mandatory Life Nights (see above) for all students in the Confirmation program and at least one of their parents. Attendance will be taken. Since the lessons discussed in the online small groups build on each week, we are asking for consecutive attendance as well.
- **3 Thursday Night Holy Hours:** Holy Hours are a time of adoration with guided meditation, music and the opportunity for confession. They take place every Thursday at Resurrection Church from 8:30-9:30 PM. **Students must check in with Mickayla at the end of Holy Hour to receive credit.**
