These families are in desperate need of basic items that most people take for granted...**laundry detergent, bleach, cleaning wipes, shampoo and conditioners, toothbrushes and toothpaste, blankets, towels, and school supplies.** As a Collaborative Outreach Project, we plan to provide these neighbors with May (laundry) Baskets filled with these essentials.

4. Sign up to help deliver the May Baskets to the Friends of the Homeless on Saturday, May 19th.

Please note: For those individuals or families who would like to participate but who cannot access the on-line sign-up, donations of gift cards to Target, CVS, Stop and Shop, Walmart, or gas are most welcome too! These can be dropped off on the weekend of May 12th and 13th or at Resurrection Church.
